Things You Should Know About VOICE 2014:

ON-SITE SIGN-IN: Our VOICE Help Desk will be open for early sign-in on Wednesday, from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., August 27th prior to our Red Carpet Reception; on Thursday and Friday mornings from 7am to 9am, and on Friday and Saturday from 8:00am to 9:00am. There will probably be someone at the Help Desk at other times as well. Please ask any of our VOICE staff or Ambassadors if you have any questions.

You will be given a name badge when you sign in. For security reasons, your badge must be visible at all times, so please wear it whenever you are attending any VOICE 2014 activity.

PLEASE NOTE: If your name badge is not visible, you may not be permitted entrance to general sessions, breakout sessions, or the Exhibit Hall.

LOST & FOUND: Please see one of our VOICE Staff or volunteers to report a lost item or if you “find” something that appears to be “lost.” We’ll do our best to help get “lost” items back to their owners.

CELL PHONES & PAGERS: Please be courteous to your fellow voice actors and turn **OFF** all cell phones and pagers, or put them on vibrate before entering the conference areas. There will be numerous scheduled breaks when you can check your calls. If you must take a call during a program, please exit the meeting room as quietly as possible before answering your phone.

OUR SCHEDULE: We are planning for concurrent sessions at this year’s convention. This means there may be more than one session that you want to attend scheduled at the same time. To minimize this problem, some presenters may offer their sessions more than once. But don’t worry if you miss a session! We will be audio recording everything and as a full-convention attendee you will receive a set of downloadable conference recordings*. We will be announcing our presenters and a basic schedule, but we will not be taking reservations for breakout sessions. It is also possible that a session you want to attend may be “sold out”. Due to Fire Marshall regulations, when a meeting room reaches capacity, our staff will not admit any further attendees.

We start promptly at 8:45am each day for our daily house keeping with General Sessions starting promptly at 9am. Please be in the main ballroom and ready to go. Doors open at 8am each day. We encourage you to sit at a different table at each session so you can meet new people. Lunch breaks will vary depending on scheduled programs. Afternoon sessions resume at 1:30pm and continue to roughly 5:00pm, except for Saturday. Our convention days are packed with programs and other events, but you will have plenty of free time visit our Exhibit Hall, mingle with other attendees to make new friends and reacquaint with old friends. If you would like to visit local attractions, we suggest you plan on arriving a few days early or stay a few days after the convention.

BUNNY SLIPPERS SATURDAY: We know you like to work in your bunny slippers, so on Saturday morning we invite you to wear your bunny slippers to our General Session (bring a change of shoes for the rest of the day if you like... or not.) If you don’t have a pair of bunny slippers, you can wear your “Funny Slippers” or even your regular shoes (we won’t tell!). **Our official VOICE 2014 Bunny Slipper Footwear Provider is www.bunnyslippers.com. Use the special offer code VOICE when you order your bunny slippers and save 15% on your order.**

THE VOICE BANQUET: As voiceover talent we tend to live our lives in relative isolation – in a recording studio VO booth or in our own home studios – and our “dress code” is usually very casual. It’s not often that we have the opportunity to “dress up.” Saturday evening is your opportunity to “Dress to the Nines” at our VOICE Banquet (Formal attire optional – or come in T-shirt and sandals if that’s your style.) To cover the cost of the dinner and the special evening program, there is an extra charge for this event. If you didn’t include the Saturday Banquet when you registered, you may still have time... Check the Registration page on the VOICE website for the deadline for booking your banquet seat(s). **To reserve your seat at the VOICE Celebrity Banquet, simply go to www.voiceconvention.com and click on the Event Upgrades menu.**

We’re sorry, but we cannot accept any late banquet reservations after the deadline has expired. We promise the VOICE Banquet will be a highlight of your VOICE 2014 experience and something you will definitely not want to miss.
